David Francis teaches at Pratt Fine Arts Center and has curated a number of shows for CoCA (Center on Contemporary Art) since 2005, including "Heaven and Earth" at Carkeek Park in 2009. He taught in Poland and Hungary as a Fulbright Lecturer in American Literature in 1998 and 2002 before focusing his work on visual media in addition to writing poetry.

Catherine Person has been professionally involved in the NW arts scene for the past 33 years, and an arts dealer since 1987. Catherine Person Gallery opened in September 2005, with a focus on contemporary art by artists from Tokyo to Tasmania and from around the United States - but who are working and residing in the Pacific Northwest

Since co-founding Modern Dog Design Co. in 1987, **Robynne Raye** has continued to do work for entertainment and retail companies - both local and national - and counts poster, packaging and identity projects as some of her favorite work. Her posters are represented in the permanent archives of the Louvre, the Library of Congress, El Centro de Desarrollo des las Artes Visuales (Havana, Cuba), Hong Kong Heritage Museum, the Warsaw National Museum, and the Cooper-Hewitt National Design Museum among others. For more than 16 years she has lectured and taught workshops, both nationally and internationally. Currently, she is an adjunct instructor at Cornish College of the Arts in Seattle. Robynne has designed all of the Greenwood-Phnney ArtWalk posters.

Apulent Events CEO **Joseph Roberts** is a CoCA curator and board member, is Copper Canyon Press board president and an avid art collector.

How to Apply:

The ArtWalk is open to all 2D and 3D visual art: painting, sculpture, photographs, printmaking, glass, metal, fiber, ceramics and mixed media. Crafts are not accepted. Please follow submission instructions.

- Send 3-5 images saved as JPEG files (not progressive) on a CD. Images must be representative of your work and created in the past two years.
- **Digital files** must be in JPEG format and saved on a CD for viewing on a PC. Each file should not exceed 2MB. The dimensions of the longest side should not exceed 1280 pixels.
- Do not embed files in a slideshow like "PowerPoint". Title each file with your last name first, followed by 1 to 5 in the order in which you would like them to be viewed. For example, John Smith's files would be Smith1.jpg, Smith2.jpg, etc. Label the CD with your name.
- Include the application form below, including contact and image information.
- Include a check for \$10 made out to Greenwood Arts Council.
- If you would like materials returned, include a properly sized, self addressed envelope with sufficient postage for the return of your materials. Otherwise your disk will be destroyed.
